There is a release lever placed on the handle that lowers the pallet back down. For any loaded pallets that weigh more than 680 kg or 1,500 lbs, a manual model may not be as useful.

An electric pallet truck lowers and raises the pallets through the push of a button and is usually self-propelled. Being utilized mostly in situations where the pallets are extremely heavy, this unit will require regular time to recharge. These electric pallet trucks can move backward and forward at different rates of speed. Various units require that an operator walks next to the machinery, while other units have a compartment for the user to ride in a standing position.

There are lift pallet trucks which are perfect for using all-around shelves which are up to 1.5 meters, or up to 5 feet tall. These types of pallet trucks are capable of raising the pallet over the traditional 10 inches or 25.5 cm. They also come in both electric and manual units.

Both kinds of non-powered and powered kinds of pallet trucks you could be considering would be particularly rated for limit weights. Lifting a pallet heavier than the machine rating specified can simply result in danger to the user, result in damage to the user and cause a voided warranty. If there is a chance you could be moving cargo which is usually heavier than 2000 lbs or 907 kg, considering the need for a lift truck or even a heavy duty truck can be a safer and more reliable choice.
